Ground Water Rule Training Announcement

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) will sponsor two **FREE** one-day Ground Water Rule (GWR) training sessions in Oklahoma. These training sessions will be held in Woodward and Midwest City. The GWR went into effect on DECEMBER 1, 2009 and affects all systems using ground water or buying from systems using ground water. Staff from the EPA Region 6 office will present the requirements of the GWR and conduct workshops to reinforce the presentation material. Staff from the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality will also be available to answer any questions you may have.

Attendees

The GWR applies to all ground water systems that have ground water sources (wells) or purchase water from systems with wells. The Rule also applies to any surface water systems (systems pulling water from a lake, river, etc.) that have wells, or purchase water from another system with any wells, and the water is introduced anywhere after the surface water treatment plant.
